Product Spotlight

Super Blush Retarder and No Blush Plus Aerosols 101

We will try to go into some depth of what these products are and how they perform in varying situations so that you can offer a more informed solution to your customers.

What is blushing? The majority of issues customers encounter are trapped moisture in the film. This is a result from spraying a coating in high moisture conditions where the coating has dried trapping the moisture in the film. These conditions worsen as we get into the summer months where higher temperatures and relative humidity can create a perfect storm for blushing problems. Another situation similar to a blush is where they apply a coating too quickly over a wipe stain or a glaze. This can be corrected in the same manner as a blush but a more common term for this situation is "solvent bloom".

No Blush Plus M103-0475 & Super Blush Retarder M103-0476

These products are similar in chemical make-up, being comprised of slow evaporative solvents so when applied, they open up the film by re-wetting it, thereby allowing the moisture (blush) to escape. Some of the reasons we recommend customers using one over another in specific situations are the effects that these products will have on a coating.

In addition to these blush removers opening up the film, a couple of other things occur. On lower sheen finishes Super Blush Retarder can displace the flattener in the film thus causing shiny spots. No Blush Plus rarely leaves shiny spots if used properly.

When using these products for blush situations it is best to apply mist coatings directly over the blushing area to address the problem. Numerous mist applications tend to work better than applying a heavy coat especially on fresh lacquer where runs in the film could occur.

We have all seen white rings in a finish usually created by a wet glass or in some cases heat from an object placed on the surface. This defect could have been trapped for years. To address this, it is important to clean the area well with M107-0190 Wax Wash™ Remover or M107-3012 Quick Clean, then apply light coats of No Blush Plus or Super No Blush and in most cases this defect will be removed. The applications mentioned are addressing blush situations in conventional lacquer finishes.

No Blush Blender Flat M103-0276

This product is unique to the blush removing products that we offer. This product was originally launched to address issues with low sheen finishes.

Years ago blush products were used extensively to reflow finishes. If a finish had light scratches or if there was trash in the finish then the technician sanded the defect with a fine grit paper and reflowed the finish with the blush eliminating product. We discussed earlier the sheen change (shiny spots) caused by standard blush removers. No Blush Blender Flat is a good fit for low sheen finishes which are now commonplace.

Low sheen finishes are also subject to abrasion, trash in film, and packing marks. These defects are seen as shiny marks in the finish. The first step is to determine if the marks are topical or in the finish itself. If the defect cannot be felt, simply apply the No Blush Blender Flat in a light mist coating and the shiny mark will disappear (two coats may be needed). For the defects that can be felt, wet sand the area with 800 grit wet / dry sandpaper to remove it. Next, sand the area again with 1000-1200 grit sandpaper. Lastly, apply No Blush Blender Flat as needed. In some cases, a slightly more wet application may be required.
